Summer activities, programmes and events in Southwark promise fun for children and young people of all ages, interests and abilities.





Inspiring and daring, this celebration of global Parasport will be held from **14 to 23 July** at the London Stadium.


With adult tickets at a reduced price of £9 each and children's tickets discounted to £3 each, the offer allows a family of four to attend for less than £25.
