FOUNDATION IN FLORISTRY DIPLOMA (LEVEL 1)

Starts: September Duration: 1 year full-time Available at: Enfield and Gunnersbury Park

On this one-year course you will receive an introduction to the world of floristry and the opportunity to develop the basic practical skills required to start in the industry.

You will:

- make floristry, planted and balloon designs for a range of occasions
- identify fresh flowers, foliage and plants
- prepare and care for cut flowers, foliage and plants
- develop skills to work safely in the industry
- design, produce and maintain window displays
- · develop employability skills.

To achieve this qualification you will have to successfully:

- · create portfolios of evidence
- complete practical assessments to demonstrate the skills you have learnt
- sit one external theory based exam
- · complete work experience.

Entry requirements

You will need at least one of the following:

- at least 2 GCSEs
- relevant prior learning or experience gained in an appropriate professional
- · environment will be considered
- a willingness and commitment to learn new skills
- enthusiasm for working with flowers
- you will be encouraged to attend our Summer School.

What next after your course?

Successful completion of this course will help build your confidence and you could progress to a Floristry Diploma (Level 2) or an Intermediate Apprenticeship in Floristry (Level 2).

We want all of our students to maximise their personal development and prospects for employment or further study. While on your course you will continue to build skills relevant to work and study on our Skills Development programmes, which may include English, maths or computer skills.

You will be asked to attend an interview to explore your interests, experience and ambitions and complete an initial assessment so that we can help you study. References are also considered.

FLORISTRY DIPLOMA (LEVEL 2)

Starts: September
Duration: 1 year full-time
Available at: Enfield, Gunnersbury Park
and Newham

This course will give you a comprehensive insight into the opportunities and expectations of the world of modern retail floristry. You will study a variety of simple floristry skills and techniques that will enable you to construct a vast range of designs suitable for weddings, funerals, events and gifts.

In addition to practical floristry and planted designs, you will also be introduced to aspects of art and design that influence floral designs and develop skills on displaying goods, both as in-store and window displays.

During this course you will also explore the conditioning of flowers, foliage and plant materials, as well as how to identify and assess quality of fresh materials.

This course will require additional private study to successfully complete course assignments and be supported with the educational industry visits.

To achieve this qualification you will have to successfully:

- create portfolios of evidence
- complete written assignments
- complete practical assessments to demonstrate the skills you have learnt
- sit one external theory based exam
- complete 150 hours of work experience.

Entry requirements

You will need at least one of the following:

- at least 4 GCSEs at grades D or above
- an overall Merit or above in Foundation in Floristry (Level 1) or equivalent
- relevant prior learning or experience gained in an appropriate professional
- · environment will be considered
- you will be encouraged to attend our Summer School.

What next after your course?

Successful completion of this course will:

- help you gain employment in the industry as a junior florist
- enable you to progress to our Floristry Advanced Diploma (Level 3) or an Advanced Apprenticeship in Floristry (Level 3).

FLORISTRY ADVANCED DIPLOMA (LEVEL 3)

Starts: September

Duration: 1 year full-time

Available at: Enfield, Gunnersbury Park
and Newham

This Floristry Advanced Diploma will provide you with comprehensive knowledge of the retail floristry industry at an advanced level. You will explore transferable traditional and contemporary skills and techniques. Using a wide selection of materials and different mediums across a range of floral designs, you will further build your confidence as a florist and expert knowledge.

Your College studies will be enriched by practical industry experience and personal creative exploration. Further to advancing your practical skills and knowledge in floristry and planted designs you will also explore the design process in greater detail and gain an insight into the operations of running a floristry business.

All courses will require additional private study for completion of course assignments.

Your course experience will be enhanced with educational industry visits.

To achieve this qualification you will have to successfully complete:

- portfolios of evidence
- written assignments
- practical assessments
- · 150 hours of work experience.

Entry requirements

You will need at least one of the following:

- · at least 4 GCSEs at grades A* to C
- an overall Merit or above in a Floristry Diploma (Level 2) or equivalent
- relevant prior learning or experience gained in an appropriate professional
- · environment will be considered
- you will be encouraged to attend our Summer School.

You will be asked to attend an interview to explore your interests, experience and ambitions and complete an initial assessment so that we can help you study. References are also considered.

What next after your course?

Successful completion of this course will:

- help you gain employment in the industry as a senior florist or in a managerial position
- enable you to explore your personal development and industry knowledge on a Level 4 Floristry programme, which can lead to becoming a Master Florist or a full Bachelor's Degree in Floristry.

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If you are looking to start work, earn money and gain a nationally recognised qualification then an Apprenticeship is for you.

Your Apprenticeship will allow you to earn while you learn, gaining knowledge and skills on the job supported by regular college visits. Giving you a foundation in the required practical skills you need for a successful career in floristry.

You will need to be employed in the floristry industry to complete this qualification, but we will help you find and apply for a job.

If you are aged 16 to 18 the cost of your tuition is free. If you are over 18, then fees may be payable, but fee waivers and bursaries are available to help and loans if you are aged 24 and over.

TRAINEESHIP IN FLORISTRY (LEVEL 1)

Starts: Various (please refer to website for further information)

Duration: full-time over 15 weeks

Available at: New Covent Garden Market

A Traineeship can help you become 'work ready' or enable you to progress to an Apprenticeship or further study. Our floristry Traineeship lasts for 15 weeks and will cover:

- work preparation ensuring you develop the confidence and skills to take the first step in your career
- practical work experience giving you a real understanding of work plus up to date skills.

Entry requirements

A Traineeship could be for you, if you are:

- motivated to work
- · aged between 16 to 24
- qualified to no more than Level 2
- unemployed (or work less than 16 hours per week) and have little work experience.

What next after your course?

Successful completion of this course will enable you to progress to an Intermediate Apprenticeship in Floristry (Level 2) or our Floristry Diploma (Level 2).

INTERMEDIATE APPRENTICESHIP IN FLORISTRY (LEVEL 2)

Starts: Rolling starts throughout the year Duration: minimum 1 year Available at: New Covent Garden Market

The aim of our Intermediate Apprenticeship in Floristry is to give you an opportunity to gain confidence, learn, develop and practise the skills required for employment and/or career progression in the floristry industry.

The Apprenticeship will last for a minimum of one year with one day a week at College in combined with training, experience and assessment in the work-place.

Entry requirements

You will need at least one of the following:

- · at least 2 GCSEs at grades D or above
- Introduction to Floristry (Level 1) or equivalent
- · you must be at least 16 on entry
- you must be employed within the floristry industry, working a minimum of 30 hours per week under a contract of employment.

What next after your course?

Successful completion of this course will enable you to continue working in the industry as a junior florist or progress to an Advanced Apprenticeship in Floristry (Level 3).

ADVANCED APPRENTICESHIP IN FLORISTRY (LEVEL 3)

Starts: Rolling starts throughout the year Duration: minimum 1 year Available at: New Covent Garden Market

Our Advanced Apprenticeship in Floristry is a great opportunity for you to further enhance and develop your practical floristry skills, grow your theoretical knowledge and gain confidence to progress into management roles in the industry. Knowledge gained at College will continue to develop whilst you are at work.

The Apprenticeship will last for a minimum of one year with one day a week at College in combined with training, experience and assessment in the work-place.

Entry requirements

You will need at least one of the following:

- at least 3 GCSEs at grades A* to C
- Intermediate Apprenticeship in Floristry (Level 2)
- · Floristry Diploma (Level 2) or equivalent
- strong practical experience within the industry with a supportive portfolio
- you must be at least 16 on entry

 you must be employed within the floristry industry, working a minimum of 30 hours per week under a contract of employment.

What next after your course?

Successful completion of this course will enable you to continue working in the industry as a junior manager; you could also progress to a Level 4 Floristry Diploma or a Higher Education Floristry programme.

Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements to this course. You do not need previous experience, just a willingness to learn and a genuine interest in floristry. Relevant prior learning experience in an appropriate professional environment will be considered.

It is aimed at students aged 19 or over and you will study a variety of basic floristry techniques that will develop your ability to construct a range of designs suitable for wedding and event displays. You will explore designs using different mediums, as well as wiring and gluing techniques. In addition to practical floristry, you will also be introduced to aspects of art and design that influence floral designs and learn how to identify and assess quality of fresh materials.

This course requires additional private study for completion of course assignments.

To achieve this qualification you will have to successfully:

- · create portfolios of evidence
- · complete written assignments
- complete practical assessments to demonstrate the skills you have learnt
- · sit one external theory based exam
- · complete work experience.

Entry requirements

You will need at least one of the following:

- at least 3 GCSEs at grades A* to C
- an overall Merit or above in Introduction to Floristry Certificate (Level 1) or equivalent
- relevant prior learning or experience gained in an appropriate professional
- · environment will be considered
- successful completion of a practical and knowledge based industry assessment.

What next after your course?

Successful completion of this course will help you gain employment in the industry as a junior florist or enable you to progress to our Professional Floristry Diploma (Level 2).

You may be asked to attend an interview to explore your interests, experience and ambitions or complete an initial assessment so that we can help you study. References are also considered.

FLORAL DESIGN CERTIFICATE (LEVEL 1)

Starts: Various (please refer to website for further information)

Duration: part-time, 1 day a week over 20 weeks

Available at: Enfield

This creative craft floral design course will provide you with a sound foundation of knowledge and competence in the skills and techniques of traditional and contemporary floral design. This course will introduce you to:

- the care and condition of plant material and mechanics
- · elements and principles of design
- plant identification
- innovative design techniques
- traditional and contemporary designs.

To achieve this qualification you will have to successfully:

- · create portfolios of evidence
- complete practical assessments to demonstrate the skills you have learnt.

Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements to this course. You do not need previous experience, just a willingness to learn and a genuine interest in floral design. Relevant prior learning experience in an appropriate professional environment will be considered.

What next after your course?

Successful completion of this course will enable you to progress to the Level 2 Floral Design Certificate (Level 2).

FLORAL DESIGN CERTIFICATE (LEVEL 2)

Starts: Various (please refer to website for further information) **Duration:** part-time, 1 day a week

over 20 weeks **Available at:** Enfield

This advanced creative craft floral design course will further develop your practical ability to creatively explore and design using traditional and non-traditional floral materials.

It will cultivate your knowledge and competence in the skills and techniques required for floral design; enhancing your ability to plan, prepare, construct and present complex designs.

This course will require additional private study to successfully complete course assignments.

To achieve this qualification you will have to successfully:

- · create portfolios of evidence
- complete written assessments
- complete practical assessments to demonstrate the skills you have learnt.

Entry requirements

You will need at least one of the following:

- an overall Merit or above in Floral Design Certificate (Level 1)
- good experience and knowledge of floral design with a portfolio of evidence of designs produced
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ an explored interest in floral design.

What next after your course?

Successful completion of this course will:

- help you gain employment in the industry as a freelance bespoke floral designer or a floral design demonstrator
- enable you to progression to a Professional Floristry Advanced Diploma (Level 3).

You may be asked to attend an interview to explore your interests, experience and ambitions or complete an initial assessment so that we can help you study. References are also considered.





VIVALDI FLOWERS

Starts: Various (please refer to website for further information)

Duration: 4 courses for spring, summer, autumn and winter (each course is 1 evening per week over 5 weeks)

Available at: Enfield and Gunnersbury Park

These short evening courses specialise in creating floral designs depicting the four seasons. You will develop the skills required to compose your own seasonal floral designs, while you identify and explore the joy of working with seasonal materials. The course is aimed to develop your knowledge on how to condition and use seasonal materials effectively and identify expressive floral techniques.

On successful completion of this course you will receive a Capel Manor College Certificate. There are no formal assignments to complete during this course, but we do suggest you produce a portfolio to document your designs and your course tutor will provide verbal feedback.

Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements to this course. You do not need previous experience, just a genuine interest in floral design and a willingness to learn new skills and techniques.

You should think about study materials, clothing and equipment that will help you in your studies and future careers. Your tutors will help you decide what is best.

What next after your course?

Vivaldi Flowers is a succession of four five-week short courses each focusing on an individual season. You may choose to explore each season over the course of the year to further develop your floral design knowledge. Or you might consider progressing from these interest courses to our Introduction to Floristry (Level 1), or our Floristry Certificate or Diploma (Level 2) or Floral Design (Level 1 and 2) courses to further your knowledge, dependant on previous education and experience, if you are considering a career in the industry.



SEASONAL WEDDING FLOWERS

Starts: Various (please refer to website for further information)

Duration: three consecutive Saturdays

Available at: Enfield

On this short specialist courses we will introduce you to basic skills required for wedding designs that use seasonal material. Over this three-week course we will explore different areas of wedding floristry and introduce simple floral techniques.

You will gain an insight into current wedding trends, recognising basic floral techniques, how to condition and use

seasonal materials effectively, as well as exploring the joy of working with seasonal materials.

On successful completion of this course you will receive a Capel Manor College Certificate. There are no formal assessments to complete during this course, but we do advise you to produce a portfolio to document your designs and your course tutor will provide verbal feedback

Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements to this course. You do not need previous experience, just a genuine interest in seasonal wedding floral designs and a willingness to learn new skills and techniques.

What next after your course?

If this course sparked an interest, you may want to enrol on one of our evening courses to develop your floral design knowledge and skills. Or you might consider progressing from this interest course to our Introduction to Floristry (Level 1), or our Floristry Certificate or Diploma (Level 2) or Floral Design (Level 1 and 2) courses to further your knowledge and skills, dependant on previous education and experience, if you are considering a career in the industry.



FLORISTRY EXPERIENCE DAYS
