How does the programme work?


Unity Futures will focus on:

- Practical skills around travel, digital inclusion, budgeting.

With additional employment support around:

- Reviewing education, training and/or jobs that would match indviduals best.
- Experience of work through visits, job fairs, taster sessions and placements.
