

Unity Futures is a new wellbeing and employment programme focusing on early engagement and interventions for young people with a learning disability (16-25) across Central London Boroughs who are or at risk of becoming NEET (Not in Education, Employment or Training).

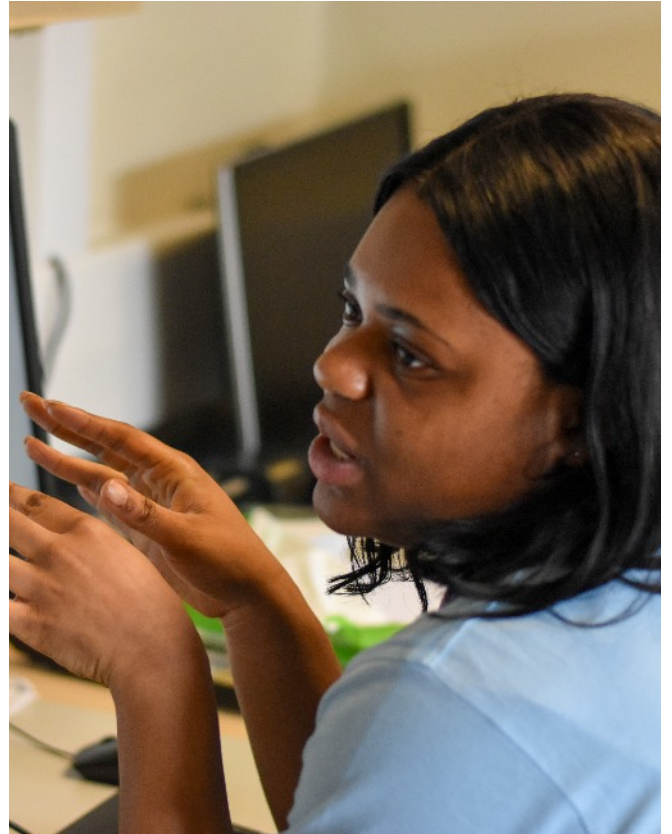
How does the programme work?

Unity Futures will focus on:

- Mental health and wellbeing.
- Developing emotional coping strategies.
- Building confidence and a 'circle of support.'
- Practical skills around travel, digital inclusion, budgeting.

With additional employment support around:

- Reviewing education, training and/or jobs that would match individuals best.
- Experience of work through visits, job fairs, taster sessions and placements.
- Support with applications, interview and in-work support
