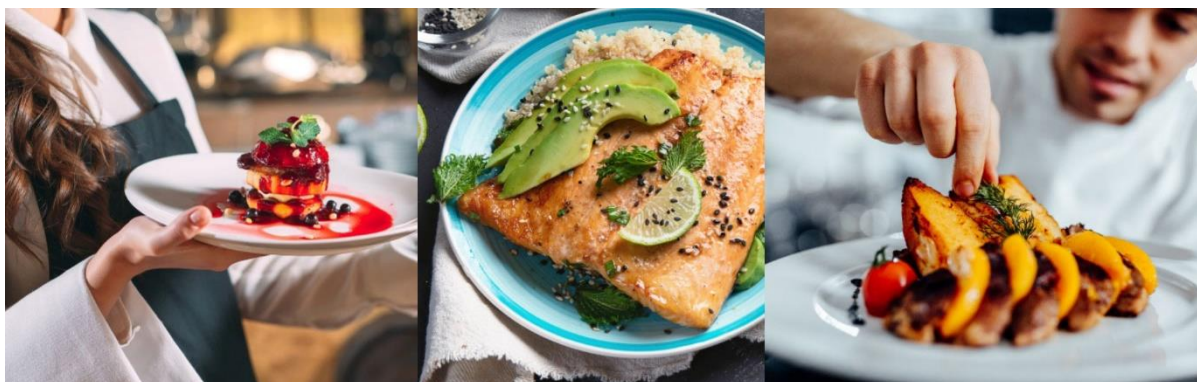


Introduction to Hospitality: Level 1 Course
