AET Making Sense of Autism	<ul> <li>To extend your understanding of how autism affects pupils in school</li> <li>To increase your expertise in recognising a pupil's individual strengths and differences</li> <li>To develop your skills in identifying barriers to learning for autistic pupils</li> </ul>
AET Good Autism Practice	Please attend the AET School Making Sense of Autism prior to signing up for this course  Develop knowledge and understanding of good autism practice  Understand practical strategies and approaches that support autistic pupils  Ensure inclusive practice for all autistic pupils.
AET Autism and Anxiety	<ul> <li>To understand how autistic pupil might express anxiety.</li> <li>To understand factors and triggers for anxiety in autistic pupils.</li> <li>To understand what you can do to prevent, reduce and effectively manage anxiety in autistic pupils.</li> </ul>
AET Developing Toileting Skills for Autistic Pupils	<ul> <li>To understand the importance of working with others to support children to develop independent toileting skills.</li> <li>To develop knowledge of how to support children to achieve toileting independence.</li> <li>To plan and deliver a child-centred toileting plan, that will ensure children make progress in developing toileting skills.</li> </ul>
Autism and Girls	<ul> <li>To understand the history of Autism research and how this relates to gender</li> <li>To understand how Autism may present differently for children of different genders</li> <li>To know a range of strategies to support Autistic girls in school</li> <li>To relate your understanding of Autism to girls at your school (diagnosed or undiagnosed)</li> </ul>
NEW	These sessions are designed as a series and participants will get the most out of them by attending all sessions in order.  Before attending the live sessions (2, 3 & 4), it is advised that you watch the 'Understanding Behaviour and how to record ABCs' prerecorded session.

Understanding behaviour and how	<ul> <li>To gain a greater understanding of the functions of behaviour</li> <li>To have opportunities to practice completing ABC charts</li> </ul>

Session 2: Analysing ABC charts	<ul> <li>Session 2</li> <li>Analyse ABC charts to understand behaviour, including looking at environmental factors, task demands, relationships with adults, communication challenges and sensory differences.</li> <li>To be able to identify patterns and unpick root causes of behaviours</li> <li>To analyse the function of behaviour and how this results in action.</li> </ul>
Session 3: De-escalation	<ul> <li>Developing an 'Unconditional Positive Regard' culture across the whole school setting</li> <li>To develop practical skills in conflict resolution in the school setting</li> <li>To understand the root causes of escalating situations and our role within them</li> <li>Understanding when to challenge and when to support in a child-centred way</li> <li>Developing scripts for staff to use to communicate effectively in heightened situations.</li> </ul>
Session 4: Developing Behaviour Support Plans	<ul> <li>Session 4</li> <li>Develop behaviour support plans by focusing on what students can do at their best and gaining pupil and parent voice.</li> <li>Learn about behaviour theories through an autistic lens</li> <li>Understanding who the support plan is for and how best to update and evaluate</li> <li>Creating a living document which reflects the current successes and challenges being addressed at school and in the home</li> <li>Make links to your school behaviour policy</li> </ul>
NEW Engagement Model	<ul> <li>To develop understanding and knowledge of the Engagement Model</li> <li>To identify pupils for whom the model would be appropriate for</li> <li>To write Engagement Profiles about specific autistic pupils you work with</li> <li>To confidently assess using the Engagement Tool and Profile in unison.</li> </ul>
Social Narratives	<ul> <li>To use a visual approach to unpick social situations with an autistic child</li> <li>To write a social narrative to model appropriate social interaction by describing a situation with relevant social cues, others' perspectives, and suggested appropriate responses.</li> </ul>





Structured Teaching (TEACCH)	<ul> <li>To gain an understanding of how structured teaching can support pupils</li> <li>Learn how to set up a structured teaching system and introduce it to a child</li> </ul>
Understanding behaviour and how to record ABC charts	<ul> <li>To gain a greater understanding of the functions of behaviour</li> <li>To have opportunities to practice completing ABC charts</li> </ul>
Using visuals to support autistic pupils	<ul> <li>To develop understanding of why and how visuals support autistic children</li> <li>Learn how to use a range of visual supports in class to support autistic children</li> <li>Opportunities to see examples of a range of visual supports</li> </ul>
AET Developing Play in the Early Years	<ul> <li>Understand how the three areas of difference in autism impact on the development of play skills.</li> <li>Understand the importance of all adults working together to support the child to develop play skills.</li> <li>Develop knowledge of how to support autistic children to develop play skills.</li> <li>Create and deliver a plan to ensure progress in play skills, which includes consideration of how to remove barriers and make reasonable adjustments.</li> </ul>
Supporting Transition and Change with Autistic pupils	<ul> <li>Explore different types of changes and transitions pupils experience at school.</li> <li>Understand why change is difficult for some Autistic people.</li> <li>Gain practical strategies and tools to support Autistic people during times of change or transition.</li> </ul>

## **Recorded training sessions**
