What is the Family Council?

The Family Council brings together parents, carers and other family members to give their views on children's services and how to create positive change in Southwark.

The Family Council provides a way for families with experience of children's services to be involved in shaping services and better practice in Southwark.

What does the Family Council do?

The Family Council meets monthly to discuss how to improve children's services in Southwark, including:

- How to help families and professionals work together
- Identifying support that families need and how it could be best provided
- How to make services easier to access.

The Family Council creates ideas and suggestions for improving children's services for families in Southwark, such as improving the information available to families and holding workshops for parents, carers and family members to discuss their views on different aspects of the way professionals work with families.

The Family Council is also asked to give their views on any proposed changes in the way children's services work and how this is likely to affect families. These views can then be taken into consideration when putting new policies in place.

Who can join the Family Council?

Anyone who is a parent, carer or other family member with experience of involvement with children's services in Southwark can join the Family Council.

Youth Offending Family Early Help Child Protection Care Leaving Care

Special Guardianship Foster Care All Age Disabilities
