Westminster Wheels: Train as a Bike Mechanic

Westminster Wheels is recruiting for Bike Mechanic Trainees!

This is a fantastic opportunity for young people who need extra support getting into long term work and would like to become a qualified bike mechanic while earning £11.05/hr.

Taster days: 21st December 2021 and 6th January 2022

Each trainee will receive:

- Paid training to achieve Level 2 Bike Mechanic Qualification (training is completed in Brixton)
- Employability Level 1 Training
- Six month placement at Westminster Wheels Bike shop (on Church Street)
- Support into long term employment after they have completed the 6 month placement (100% of our last cohort have found long term employment)



To be eligible, candidates must:

- Be 16-24 & NEET
- A Westminster resident (and ideally on Universal Credit)

NEETs Central Employment Mentoring Scheme

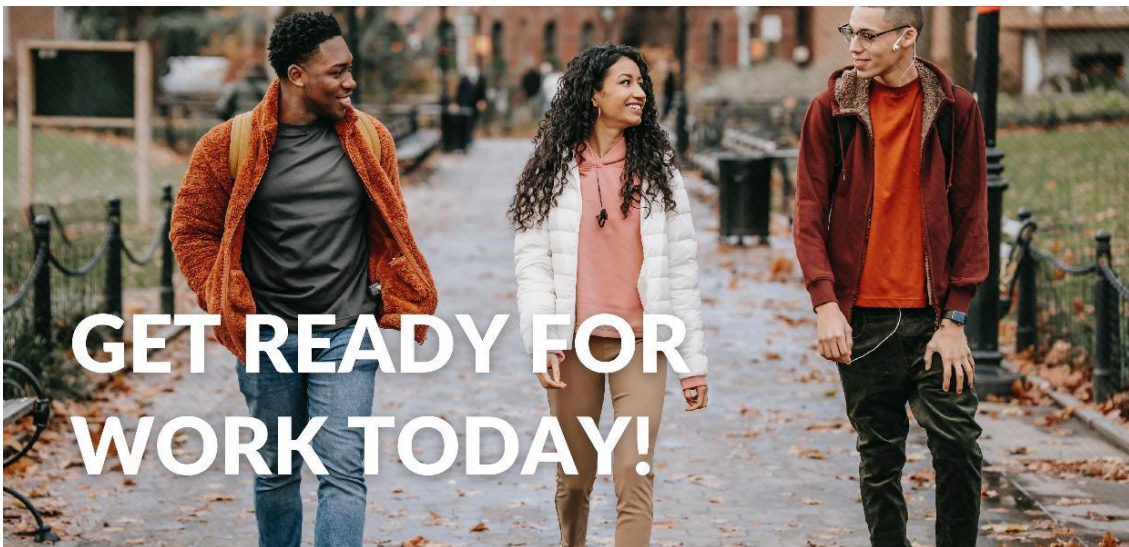

Additional Groundwork Employability & Kickstart Pathways

Candidates for the current Kickstart vacancies will receive pre-employability support and complete a short Level 1 Employability Training to prep them into work. Candidates must be on Universal Credit.

- **Junior NEET Project Officer:** Shadowing an experienced Employment Advisor, learning to provide advice and guidance to people who are unemployed, supporting them to gain qualifications and apply for jobs, editing CVs and preparing for interviews. - £10.85/hr
- **Youth Programme Assistant:** Working across multiple youth programmes, assisting with organising events in schools and activities for young people, conducting administrative tasks and supporting with running various events. - £10.85/hr
