Introduction to supporting children with Autism at Secondary School

Aims

- To have a greater understanding of the difficulties students with Autism may face in a Secondary School
- To learn ways to better support students with Autism in a mainstream Secondary School (proactive and management strategies).

This session will be led by an experienced member of the Autism Support Team who provide support for children with a diagnosis of ASD in mainstream schools across Southwark.

The course will explore the key characteristics of autism, i.e. social communication, social relationships and restricted and repetitive patterns of behaviour and how these impact on pupils' learning. Participants will also be introduced to strategies that are available to support pupils' learning style.
