On 12 October last year Ofsted and the Care Quality Commission launch

consultation on proposals for **inspecting** local areas' effectiveness in identifying and meeting the needs of children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities.

Independent inspection, combined with local and national accountability measures, will show how the SEN and disability system is performing; which parts are working well and less well and whether outcomes are improving for children and young people.

Starting in May 2016 teams will inspect all Councils including a random selection of schools, early years and FE providers.

Look out for a special inspection edition of the local offer newsletter in April 2016.
