Our FGM Champions Training

Female genital mutilation refers to procedures that intentionally alter or cause injury to the female genital organs for non-medical reasons. The practice is a gross violation of women and girls rights and is illegal in the UK.

Africa Advocacy Foundation is part of a nationwide initiative working to end female genital mutilation. We aim to create awareness, educate and empower young African women and girls at risk of FGM within practicing communities. We deliver a range of activities including campaigns, information, advice and guidance, small group discussions, referrals and support.
